- 1987: Revised PMBOK published
- 1996: Comprehensive Update and release of the new PMI "A Guide to the PMBOK"
- 1998: First version of the manual in French
- Anticipated release of future updates:
 - Every two years, or as changes occur within profession

As with other professions such as law, medicine, and accounting, the body of knowledge rests with the practitioners and academics who apply and advance it. The full PMBOK includes knowledge of proven, traditional practices which are widely applied as well as knowledge of innovative and advanced practices which have seen more limited use.
